QUALITY TIMBERS

Here are some pictures of finish and species options available at Whiteman Lumber. We use a 60" circle saw and as a result our rough sawn is very attractive. We can saw up to 24" in width. We have a four-sided planer that can surface up to 14" x 20".



This picture, courtesy of Timberbuilt in New York, shows one of the nicest products we make, a kiln dried and then resawn Douglas-fir timber. Initially these timbers are oversized and then dried. After drying they are put back in the mill and resawn to the dimensions specified by the customer. This process will cut out any twist or sweep that results from drying and will also remove a lot of the checking. The result is a timber that is stable and perfectly sized.
